I am very happy to outline the details of the role to all who are interested.

Annual Editorial Board Meeting

The JISTE Editorial Board held its annual meeting on June 23, 2022. Leanne Taylor chaired the meeting, which was held online. We met online to accommodate Editorial Board members who were unable to attend the 2022 ISfTE Seminar in Brazil.

The biggest development this year has been our **move to an open access format.** As you all may know, JISTE launched its open access site in February 2022. Thank you to the open access support from Brock University who assisted getting it up and running. We received the first online submissions in February and issue 26.1 was published fully online in July. Issues 25.1 and 25.2 have also been uploaded to the online site. Moving forward, all future JISTE issues will be available only through the online site.

So far, the transition to open access has been fairly smooth. But like all transitions, we expect we may need to make some adjustments to the JISTE platform. The Editorial Board continues to review and discuss how we can improve the process and ensure JISTE's ongoing quality and success.

Detailed instructions are available online for authors wishing to submit articles. The site includes checklists and reminders that authors will find useful when preparing their submissions. We encourage authors to refer to these guidelines to ensure smooth processing.

Changes to JISTE guidelines

At our Editorial Board meeting, we adjusted the submission guidelines slightly. Please note that the word limit for submissions is now 5500 words not including references or appendices. This change allows authors more flexibility in their papers since they no longer need to include lengthy references/appendices in the word count. All guidelines are available on the JISTE website.

Reminders

Publication in JISTE requires authors to be paid ISfTE members. If you are publishing in JISTE and not already a paid ISfTE member, please contact Melina Alexander (ISfTE Treasurer) to pay your \$75USD membership fee.

Publications

25.2 was published in December 2021. **Theme**: Transitions in Teaching and Learning: Navigating Shifting Contexts

26.1 was published in July, 2022. Theme: Cultural Relevance in Education: International Comparisons

26.2 is currently in preparation. DeeDee and David are finalizing and formatting the accepted manuscripts for this issue. It will be published at the end of December, 2022.

Please consider submitting papers for publication in JISTE 27.1. This is an open issue. The submission deadline is February 15, 2022. The journal will be published in July 2022. Authors are welcome to submit articles at any time but will be considered for the subsequent issue if received after the deadline. In the summer of 2021, Jackie Chan and I started a transition of communication outlets from his to my hands. This was finalized in September 2022, with the migration of ISfTE website from a server in Asia to a server in North America. The website has the same domain name (https://isfte.org), with added privacy and premium security. These changes should increase the page loading speed on our website, as well as prevent cyber attacks, privacy treats and similar malicious intent. The website content is still managed through Wordpress CMS and will be hosted on a server powered by Bluehost. We most sincerely apologize for any problems you may have experience during this transition.

As we were preparing our annual report for ISfTE 2022 in Brazil, we realized that our main dissemination channels were Facebook, website and email. To attract and appeal to younger members of our ISfTE community, as well as give an opportunity to members to connect to each other, we now also have an Instagram and LinkedIn page, so please join us there as well. Links are provided below.

From May of 2021 to May 2022, we posted 10 times on our social media and sent 12 announcements via email. The most popular post in this past year was the post which announced that the JISTE Open Access website was live! This testified to all our excitement about the amazing work Leanne Taylor did to increase the visibility of our journal.

Another area that we decided to work on is to do a better job of tracking website traffic, as Wordpress only offers insight into blog post views. To that end, we started using Google Analytics on May 7th, 2022. This feature allows us to see the number of users, where they are redirected from (direct search vs referral), which country they visit us from, which pages are most used and similar.

Thank you all for your patience during our website migration! We are working hard to set everything up as soon as possible.


